## Prayers of Penitence

When the Lord comes, he will bring to light things now hidden in darkness, and will disclose the purposes of the heart. In that light, let us confess our sins. Almighty God, our heavenly Father, we have sinned against you and against our neighbour in thought and word and deed, through negligence, through weakness, through our own deliberate fault. We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us all that is past and grant that we may serve you in newness of life to the glory of your name. Amen.

#### The leader declares God's forgiveness:

Almighty God, who in Jesus Christ has given us a kingdom that cannot be destroyed, forgive us our sins, open our eyes to God's truth, strengthen us to do God's will and give us the joy of his kingdom, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

### The Peace

The God of peace makes us holy in all things, that we might be ready at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The peace of the Lord be always with you **and also with you.** 

We offer one another a socially distanced sign of peace.

Eucharistic Prayer (prayer E)

The Lord is here. **His Spirit is with us.** 

Lift up your hearts. We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give thanks and praise.

The minister praises God for his mighty acts ... for ever praising you, and saying: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest.

The minister recalls the Last Supper and this acclamation may be used: Great is the mystery of faith: Christ has died: Christ is risen:

#### Christ will come again.

The Prayer continues, and ends:

... all honour and glory are yours O loving Father, forever and ever.

#### Amen.

### The Lord's Prayer

As our Saviour taught us, so we pray Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever. Amen.

### Breaking of the Bread

Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ. Though we are many, we are one body because we all share in one bread.

### Giving of Communion

Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Blessed are those who are called to his supper. Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed.

The minister receives communion and says The body of Christ, keep us all in eternal life. Amen. The blood of Christ, shed for all of us. Amen.

### Prayer after Communion

The Post Communion prayer is said O Lord our God, make us watchful and keep us faithful as we await the coming of your Son our Lord; that, when he shall appear, he may not find us sleeping in sin but active in his service and joyful in his praise; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Father of all, we give you thanks and praise, that when we were still far off you met us in your Son and brought us home. Dying and living, he declared your love, gave us grace, and opened the gate of glory. May we who share Christ's body live his risen life; we who drink his cup bring life to others; we whom the Spirit lights give light to the world. Keep us firm in the hope you have set before us, so we and all your children shall be free, and the whole earth live to praise your name; through Christ our Lord. Amen.
