#### History of St John's Church

I was contacted by a gentleman in Sweden who saw an archived article that had appeared in his local newspaper which does a feature of past events 90 years ago. The newspaper is called "Dagens Nyheter" (Today's News). Nice to know that in 1935 we reached Sweden.

"In the church in Farsley, near Bradford in England, the old and malfunctioning church bells have been replaced with a modern loudspeaker system and a gramophone, from which parishioners can now instead listen to the country's finest church bells alternately, such as Westminster Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, York, etc. The sound can be heard clearly from two miles away". 3rd November 1935
